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Guided Reading Workshops

Reading Workshop is about teachers teaching reading strategies (not teaching books) and students authentically using those strategies immediately in their self-selected,

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leveled books. Components of Reading Workshop Read Aloud/Shared Reading - 5 minutes (video example) This is where the teacher uses a mentor text to model a reading strategy.

Reading Workshop - Guided Reading and Reading Workshop

Participants learn how to implement the

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structure and components of a Reading Workshop model in order to teach reading routines and habits, comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary. They examine the characteristics of a mini lesson, the options during work time, the structure of a reading conference, and the importance of sharing and reflecting.

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Workshops & Seminars - Children's Literacy Initiative

Each Reading Workshop session begins with a mini-lesson that lasts approximately 10-15 minutes. During each mini-lesson, the teacher introduces a specific concept, also known as the teaching point. Most often, the teaching

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point focuses on a reading strategy or skill. The teacher will explicitly model or demonstrate the skill for the students.

Reading Workshop is one of the key components in a balanced literacy program. The purpose of Reading

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Workshop is to promote fluency and to provide time to nurture the love of reading and to learn about texts in a variety of ways. Reading Workshop builds a community of readers as students receive support from their peers and interact with each other to develop good literacy skills.

Simply put, guided reading is an instructional approach when the teacher works with a small group (up to 6) of

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students. The teacher is teaching specific skill or strategy to the small group of readers. These students may or may not be reading the same exact text or at the same exact reading level.
