It is scored for five vocal parts (two sopranos, alto, tenor and bass), and a Baroque orchestra including trumpets and timpani. It is the first major liturgical composition on a Latin text by Bach.

BWV 243 - The Bach Choir of Bethlehem
The Magnificat is the first large choral work that Bach composed after his appointment in Leipzig in the spring of 1723. It is an 'old-fashioned' but delightful five-voiced work that uses Latin, just like the other rarity among Bach's works, the Mass in B minor.
