fSuturing Techniques 2- Continuous Suture: A- This is usually used for suturing long incision e.g., incision for reshaping of the alveolar ridge in the maxilla and mandible. B- In this technique a knot is not made for each stitch, making the technique quick, with few knots to collect debris.

Incision Designs & Suturing Technique in Oral Surgery-part ...

Most commonly used are 3/8 circles in oral cavity (Figure 3). They can be easily manipulated in large and superficial wounds and require only less wrist movement. 1/2 circle used for suturing tissues in small wounds, and body cavities and orifices. Require less space, but more supination and pronation of wrist required.

Dental Suturing Materials and Techniques

This suturing technique is primarily used to eliminate dead space in the depth of a wound. By default, always use absorbable sutures when using this technique. Figure-of-8 sutures. The (vertical) 'Figure of 8 suture' is a combination of a subcutaneous and a surface skin suture. Use this suture to save a bit of time when closing a long incision.

Much of the process surrounding suture selection depends on surgeon training and preference. A wide variety of suture materials are available for each surgical location and surgical requirement.

What are the principles of suturing technique selection?

For instance, when using silk or chromic gut, or plain gut suture material, a slip surgical knot should be used. SLIP KNOT involves a tie in one

direction, and a second tie in the same direction, and then a third tie in the opposite direction so square the knot and hold it permanently.

Suturing techniques involved in dental surgery

This suture technique uses several strands of suture material to close the wound. After a stitch is made, the material is cut and tied off. This technique leads to a securely closed wound.

Surgical Suture: Types, Vs. Stitches, More

Technique The procedure is simple and repetitive. A single interrupted suture is used to make the initial tie. The needle is next inserted through the outer surface of the buccal flap and the underlying surface of the lingual flap. The needle is then passed through the remaining loop of the suture, and the suture is pulled tightly, thus locking it. This procedure is continued until the final suture is tied off at the terminal end 146

A type of nonresorbable suture material that's frequently used with oral surgery is braided silk. As advantages, and as compared to resorbable materials: Braided silk is easier for the dentist to handle and tie. Knots are less likely to come loose.

Dental stitches (dissolving vs regular) as used with tooth ...

This suture is performed as a variation of a continuous subcutaneous suture. The interlaced suturing technique will provide extra resistance and will retain most of the tension, making it possible to perform a tension-free skin suture. The interlaced suture acts as an antislippage suture.
